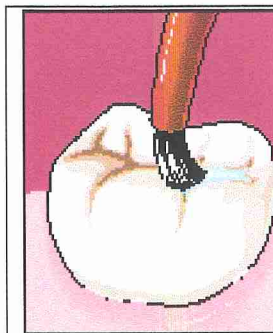
SEAL INDIANA is a statewide mobile dental program

are **NOT** receiving regular dental care or dental sealants.

A **dental sealant** is a plastic material applied to the chewing surface of back teeth where decay occurs most often. Sealants protect these teeth from plaque and acid that causes decay. Receiving sealants is comfortable, and no anesthetic is required.

A **fluoride varnish treatment**  
provides added protection against decay for all teeth.
